The online platform allows our students to not only use the curriculum programs during the school day, but also gives them access to the programs when they are away from school, provided they have Internet service.*

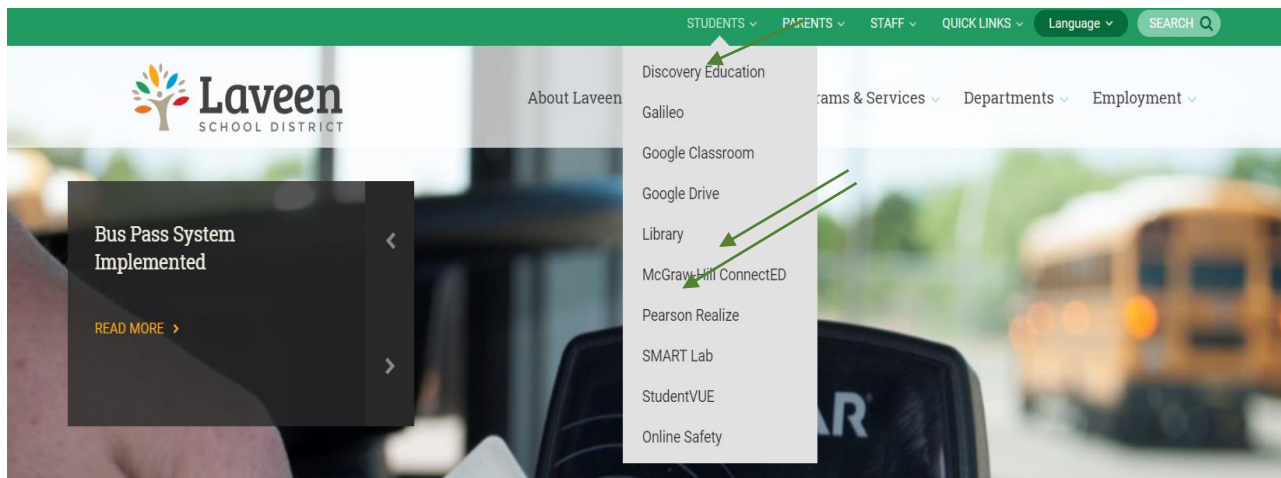
Each student should be provided with a username and password from his/her teacher. One single sign-on through Google gives students access to all of our digital curriculum programs:

Discovery Education – Science for Grades K-8 and Social Studies for Grades 5-8

McGraw-Hill ConnectED – Math for Grades K-8 and ELA for Grades K-3

Pearson Realize – ELA for Grades 4-8
