Laveen's Paseo Pointe School to Welcome Governor Ducey

(Laveen, Arizona, April 8, 2019) Paseo Pointe School will welcome Governor Doug Ducey on Tuesday, April 9. The Governor will visit several classrooms including Paseo's Dual Language Immersion classes, where he will witness similar lessons being taught in English and Spanish, and the school's media club where he will be interviewed as part of the student-run newscast. The Governor is also expected to read an Arizona-themed story, "Three Little Javelinas" to first grade students.

The tour will conclude with a round table discussion centered on the Arizona Teachers Academy-the Governor's initiative to encourage college students to pursue a teaching degree without student debt being a deterring factor. Students who enter this program agree to commit one year to teaching for each year they receive the scholarship. The Laveen School District has several student teachers and interns that are part of this program.
